



## Procedures – with Covid-19 guidelines

### **What I (Fiona Palmer) and the teachers of FFF will be doing for you and your children...**

- A full Covid-19 risk assessment has been completed.
- Government guidance for after school clubs and sporting activities for children is being followed in full.
- Details of each child attending are taken to comply with the NHS track and trace system.
- The hall we are using will be well ventilated with windows open and where possible doors open too.
- Between each class a deep clean will be done of the hall, toilets and entrances/exits.
- Hand sanitiser will be available throughout the sessions.
- Teachers will be social distancing from the students too with their own dance space.
- Each child has its own bubble with no more than 15 people in that bubble. So, students will not be mixing with large groups of children as they may normally do.
- A one-way system in and out of the buildings we hire, please ask children to look out for this.
- Should first aid need to be performed each teacher will have the appropriate PPE to wear when caring for your child.
- There will be no physical contact throughout the classes between students or teachers. Sadly, this means no hugs or holding hands in classes.
- All classes will have rubber spots down to help children social distance throughout class.
- Full details of all children attending will be taken to comply with the NHS track and trace procedures.

### **What you can do for me....**

- Please can all students be dropped off and picked up at the entrance of each building, parents are not to come in and wait in communal areas.
- Please can all students bring their own water bottle/drink, which will be kept in their own designated place in the hall.
- Students will need to wear their regular uniform to class.
- If possible, can students please use the toilet before they arrive. There are toilets on site to be used but it reduces the risk of infection if people don't need to use the ones at venues.
- Masks will NOT be required in class.
- Students will be expected to social distance throughout classes. Teachers will have rubber spots on the floor spaced out so that each student will have adequate space to dance and move about, also allowing for space between each student to let them travel between other students.
- Students must wear shoes to class, either their tap shoes, ballet shoes or trainers/jazz shoes for modern.
- If your child or a family member (living with your child) is classed as extremely vulnerable and/or shielding please do not attend dance classes.
- Your child cannot attend the dance classes if they have a high temperature, persistent cough, loss of smell or taste or a rash. Or if they should be isolating.
- Full PPE is available for the teachers in the unlikely event of a child becoming unwell. The child will be taken to a separate area immediately and the Parent/Carer will be contacted to collect them straight away.
- Children to arrive ready dressed for dancing as there will be no changing facilities.
