- Sanitise hands when entering/leaving class.
- 15 minute break between classes to clean/ventilate the room.
- Smaller class sizes to allow for space.
- Still bubbles of 15 to minimise mixing of students.
- Please can parents also ensure they remain 2m apart when waiting to collect/drop off.
